

Mum desperate to leave council flat where she keeps finding dead mice

A mum-of-two from South Norwood says she is "disgusted" that a pest problem in her flat - which she says been ongoing for the last four years - still hasn't been sorted.

Hanna Ennis says she regularly finds mice, bugs and larvae in her home in Regina Road which she shares with her children Latoya, 7, and Romeo, 4.

She says she has been complaining about the pest problems since the day she moved in and still sees mice and bugs "coming up from under her floorboards".

The pests, she adds, have been spotted in her children's bedrooms as well as in the kitchen and living room, with her daughter on one occasion waking up to find a dead mouse on her bed.

"When I went to look at the flat, there was nothing to suggest we would have any problems at all," she explained.

"But on the first day I moved in, I saw there were these black bugs everywhere and then I found these larvae, which were red and fluffy.
