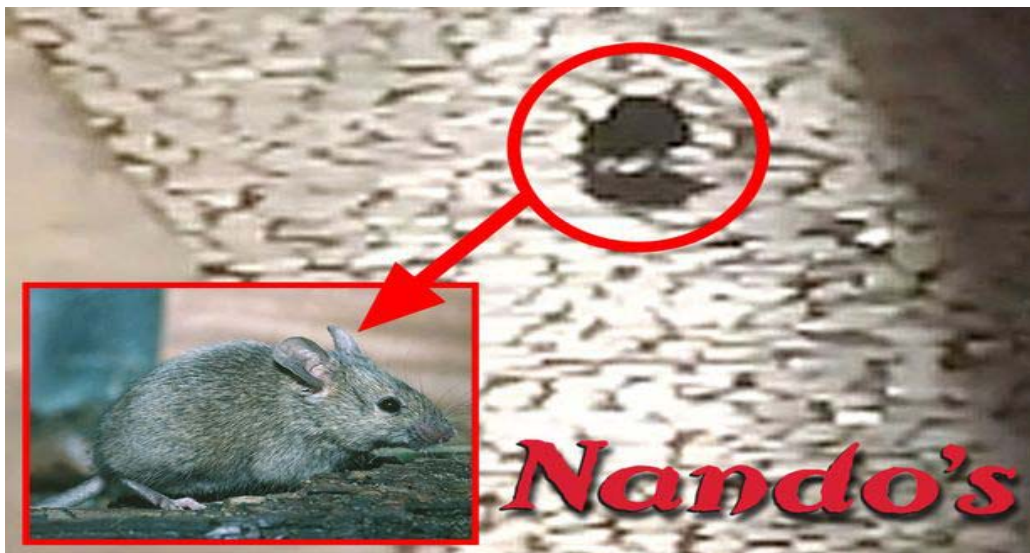


Shock images show mice running around in Edinburgh Nando's after closing time

A taxi driver in the city filmed vermin inside the popular chain after claiming nothing had been done despite his complaints.

These shocking images show mice running around a Nando's after closing time.

A cabbie filmed the rodents in the restaurant chain's outlet on Edinburgh's George IV Bridge last week.

The taxi driver, who asked not to be named, said he's seen the vermin several times while passing the Nando's during a night shift.

He claimed despite complaints to the popular South African chain, who are famous for their peri-peri chicken dishes, nothing had been done.

The cabbie said: "I've let them know but it still keeps happening, so I took the video as proof."

Another local said: "Lots of people who pass by see them once the shop's closed."

"Rodents are a problem in Edinburgh's Old Town but restaurant managers should be on top of it."

A Nando's spokeswoman said: "A pest control issue was identified in our Edinburgh restaurant last month."

"We immediately took steps to resolve this. We are confident we took the necessary action and are not aware of any recurrence."

"This restaurant meets all the environmental health organisation requirements."
